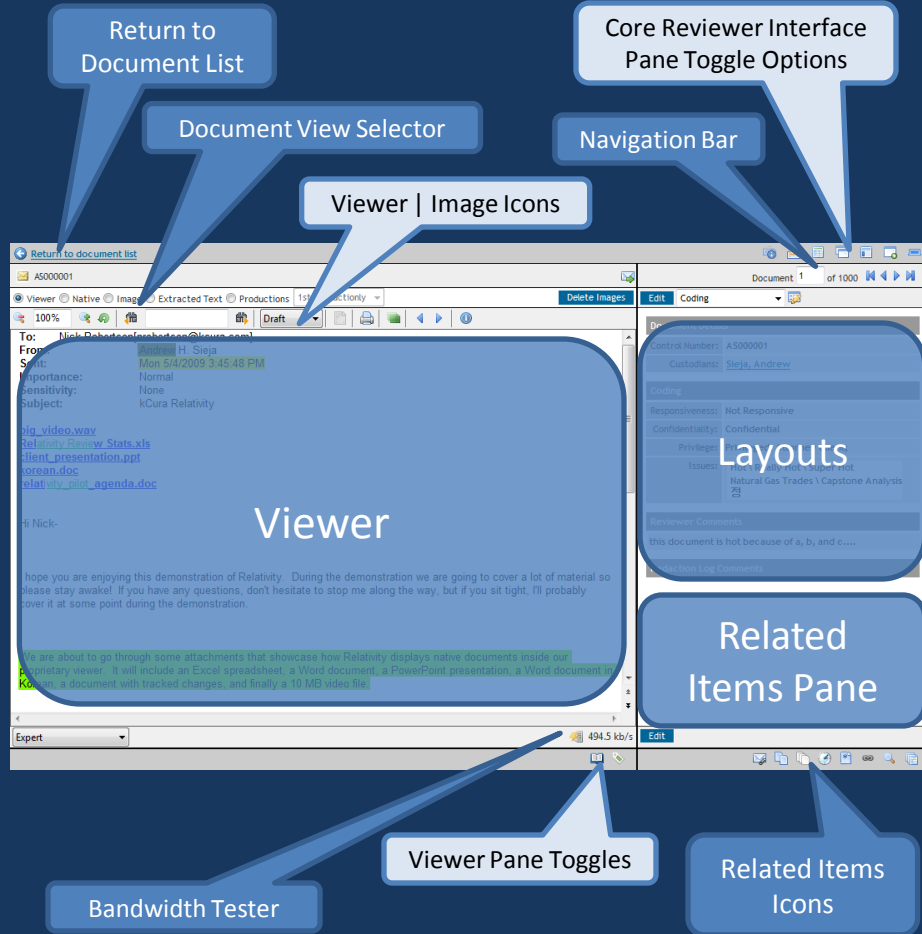


Case Workspace Areas	
<b>Pivot Menu</b>	Activate Pivot Grid and Pivot Chart – data analysis tools
<b>User Dropdown</b>	Access your workspace list, links, and personal settings
<b>Tab Strip</b>	Navigate between the different sections of your case
<b>Search Index Selector</b>	Select from available searching indexes; descriptions and details can be found in the Relativity Searching Guide
<b>Browser</b>	Browse through documents using folders, saved searches, or the field tree
<b>View Bar</b>	Controls which documents and fields are displayed in the document list
<b>Bread Crumb</b>	Shows current browser location
<b>Document List Manager</b>	Central location for viewing and acting on your documents
<b>Mass Operations Bar</b>	Options to take mass actions on some or all documents in the document list
<b>Document Set Info Bar</b>	Controls how your searching set is returned and displayed
View Bar	
	Show the current browser location
Documents	Select the view to be displayed
In This Folder & Subfolders	Select whether to view the documents in the selected folder or in the folder and its subfolders
Include Duplicates	Select whether to include related items in the current view
	Edit the current view
	Add a new view
Document Browser Menu	
	<b>Folders</b> Navigate the folder hierarchy for your workspace
	<b>Advanced or Saved Searches</b> Create a new saved search or access previously created saved searches
	<b>Field Tree</b> Displays a tree of field selections
	<b>Clusters</b> Shows the Relativity Analytics cluster hierarchy
Document Set Info Bar	
Viewing the <b>First 1,000</b>	Sets the number of documents in your returned document set; this is the number of documents you can browse through in the document list and core reviewer interface
<b>of 73,973 items</b>	The number of documents in your searchable set
in sets of <b>25</b> per page	Sets the number of items in your displayed documents set; this is the number of documents displayed at one time on the document list



# Core Reviewer Interface



## Core Reviewer Interface Areas

<b>Document View Selector</b>	Select which form of the current document you would like to display in the viewer
<b>Viewer</b>	Displays the current document in the selected form
<b>Navigation Bar</b>	Browse through documents
<b>Layouts</b>	Customizable coding forms for viewing and editing of the current document's fields
<b>Related Items Pane</b>	Quickly identify and act on documents related to the active document

## Viewer Pane Toggle Options

	Shows/hides transcript word index
	Shows/hides right-click tag list

## Core Review Interface Pane Toggle Options

	Displays the keyboard shortcuts legend
	Enables and disables keyboard shortcuts
	Shows/hides the document list from the Core Reviewer Interface
	Docks/Undocks the viewer from the Core Reviewer Interface; useful in a multi monitor review
	Flips the viewer from the left side of the window to the right, or vice-versa
	Pops out a static standalone version of the viewer
	Shows/hides tab strip
